Registration Opens for 2023 Joseph Smith Papers Conference



The Church Historian's Press invites you to attend the seventh Joseph Smith Papers Conference, which will be held 15–16 September 2023 at the Conference Center of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Salt Lake City, Utah.

This year's event will commemorate the completed print series and explore the question "What have we learned from the Joseph Smith Papers Project?"

The keynote address will be delivered by [Dr. Laurie F. Maffly-Kipp](#), Archer Alexander Distinguished Professor at Washington University in St. Louis. Opening remarks will be delivered by President Dallin H. Oaks, first counselor in the First Presidency of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Over thirty presenters, including scholars in Latter-day Saint history and historians and editors with the Joseph Smith Papers, will explore major themes of the papers, assess the project's value for scholars and Latter-day Saints, and reflect on the work of publishing nearly thirty volumes of Joseph Smith's documents.
